(1) Filing an appeal

If any Bidder or prospective bidder is aggrieved that any decision, action or omission of the Procuring Entity is in contravention to the provisions of the Act or the Rules or the Guidelines issued there under, he may file an appeal to First Appellate Authority, as specified in the Bidding Document within a period of ten days from the date of such decision or action, omission, as the case may be, clearly giving the specific ground or grounds on which he feels aggrieved:

Provided that after the declaration of a Bidder as successful the appeal may be filed only by a Bidder who has participated in procurement proceedings:

Provided further that in case a Procuring Entity evaluates the Technical Bids before the opening of the Financial Bids, an appeal related to the matter of Financial Bids may be filed only by a Bidder whose Technical Bid is found to be acceptable,

- (2) The officer to whom an appeal is filed under para (1) shall deal with the appeal as expeditiously as possible and shall endeavour to dispose it of within thirty days from the date of the appeal.
- (3) If the officer designated under para (l) fails to dispose of the appeal filed within the period specified in para (2), or if the Bidder or prospective bidder or the procuring Entity is aggrieved by the order passed by the First Appellate Authority, the Bidder or prospective bidder or the Procuring Entity, as the case may be, may file a second appeal to Second Appellate Authority specified in the bidding document in this behalf within fifteen days from the expiry of the period specified in para (2) or of the date of receipt of the order passed by the First Appellate Authority, as the case may be.

(4) Appeal not to lie in certain cases

No appeal shall lie against any decision of the Procuring Entity relating to the following matters, namely:-

- (b) The fee shall be paid in the form of bank Demand Draft or banker's Cheque of a Scheduled Bank in India payable in the name of Appellate Authority concerned.

(7) Procedure for disposal of appeal

- (a) The First Appellate Authority or Second Appellate Authority, as the case may be, Up on filing of appeal, shall issue notice accompanied by copy of appeal, affidavit and documents, if any, to the respondents and fix date of hearing.
- (b) On the date fixed for hearing, the First Appellate Authority or Second Appellate Authority, as the case may be, shall,-

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Annexure 4: Additional Conditions of Contract

1. Correction of arithmetical errors

Provided that a Financial Bid is substantially responsive, the Procuring Entity will correct arithmetical errors during evaluation of Financial Bids on the following basis

- i if there is a discrepancy between the unit price and the total price that is obtained by multiplying the unit price and quantity, the unit price shall prevail and the total price shall be corrected, unless in the opinion of the Procuring Entity there is an obvious misplacement of the decimal point in the unit price, in which case the total price as quoted shall govern and the unit price shall be corrected.
- ii if there is an error in a total corresponding to the addition or subtraction of subtotals, the subtotals shall prevail and the total shall be corrected; and
- iii if there is a discrepancy between words and figures, the amount in words shall prevail, unless the amount expressed in words is related to an arithmetic error, in which case the amount in figures shall prevail subject to (i) and (ii) above. If the Bidder that submitted the lowest evaluated Bid does not accept the correction of errors, its Bid shall be Disqualified and its Bid Security shall be forfeited or its Bid Securing Declaration shall be executed.

2. Procuring Entity's Right to Vary Quantities

- (i) At the time of award of contract. the quantity of Goods, Works or Services originally specified in the Bidding Document may be increased or decreased by a specified percentage, but such increase or decrease shall not exceed twenty percent, of the quantity specified in the Bidding Document. It shall be without any change in the unit prices or other terms and conditions of the Bid and the conditions of contract.
- (ii) If the procuring Entity does not procure any subject matter of procurement or procures less than the quantity specified in the bidding document due to change in circumstances, the Bidder shall not be entitled for any claim or compensation except otherwise provided in the Conditions of Contract.

MATERIAL AND MANUFACTURE: For 01 Lit. Ghee CFC (Lined cartons)

The corrugated boxes shall be manufactured in the shape of cubical / rectangular parallelepiped. The blanks shall be properly creased or slotted so that after assembly no holes shall be left the corners. The flaps on the boxes shall be capable of being folded at an angle of 180 degrees along the line of creasing without fracture of board of facing. There should be no gap in between flaps on folding.

TECHNICAL:

- 1. **Lap joints:** The CFC joint shall be made by a lap. The width of lap shall not be less than 30 mm. The joints shall be stapled with 7 staples with 2 x 2 and 1 x 3. The staples shall be centrally located alongwith the lap may be either straight or at the angle of. 45 degrees. The staple shall be placed in such a way that they do not fall more than 50 mm. apart from each other in each row and first and last no farther than 25 mm. from beginning and ended joint respectively. The staples shall be made of mild steel, galvanized 24 BGX 13 mm. crown x 13 mm. width and shall be of good quality.
- 2. **Flutes:** The type of flutes shall be narrow (B) with a height of minimum 2.4 mm. and maximum 2.9 mm. The number of flutes per 30 cm shall be minimum 52 maximum 56.
- 3. **Printing:** Offset printing or equivalent to offset in two colour and Art work colour printing and design as approved by RCDF from time to time.
- 4. **Adhesive:** Adhesive used should be starch based on dextrin capable of firmly adhering the various plies Together. Silicates or highly alkaline will not be used. The adhesive used shall be adequately resistant to moisture and climate in the country. The minimum quantity of glue shall be 20 gm on dry wt. basis.
- 5. **Tolerance limits:** A tolerance of ± 2 mm in case of dimension and $\pm 7\%$ in case of grammage of paper is permissible.
- 6. **Bursting strength:** When tested in accordance with standard ISI method (IS:1060/Part-1/1966) the Average bursting strength of 3 ply single wall corrugated fiber board shall be not less than 6 kg/cm2. The average shall be based on at least five determinations on each face.
- 7. **Compression strength:** When tested by standard ASIM method but conditioned at a temperature of 27 + 2 C and 5 pH, the average compression strength of the 3 Ply single walled fiber box shall be not less than 200 kg.

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Inspections and Tests

It is necessary for suppliers to maintain quality of the materials supplied as per the prescribed standards and specifications.

Milk Unions will get the quality of materials tested at their own laboratory or through the central quality control lab (CQCL) at RCDF, Jaipur.
